Sir Mark Jones is no stranger to Edinburgh and we are delighted that he has agreed to give our Annual Society Lecture. After 18 years at the British Museum, in 1992 Mark was appointed Director of the National Museums of Scotland, where he oversaw the creation of the Museum of Scotland. He moved to London in 2001 to become Director of the V & A Museum during a period of renovation and renewal and he gave the go ahead for the V & A Dundee. After 10 years he left to become Master of St. Cross College, Oxford and retired from that post in September 2016. The Bute Snuffbox is an object in the Museum of Scotland he knows well and is the subject of his intriguing lecture on its connection with George III and the Jacobites.

A wine and canapés reception at 6.00 pm will be followed by the lecture at 7.00 pm. Doors open at 6.00 pm and entry to the Museum will be by the Lothian Street Auditorium entrance.
