

VISIT TO THE ROYAL SCOTS DRAGOON GUARDS REGIMENTAL MUSEUM, EDINBURGH CASTLE, ON 17TH OR 19TH APRIL 2018. 6.30 – 8.30pm



At the kind invitation of the Curator, Mr Edwin Rutherford, we will assemble in the RSDG Regimental offices in the Castle where we will be introduced to the long and illustrious history of the Regiment over refreshments. We will then tour the museum with the curator who will point out items in the collection and link them with their history, starting with General Sir Tam Dalzell who was involved in the early days with his cavalry regiment of Scots Greys in the Royalist cause during the Civil war, through such events as Waterloo, to the present day where the Regiment has been involved in some of the world's current war zones. The event should take two hours. There will only be 20 members per evening so a ballot may have to be made if oversubscribed. The museum is quite cramped so seating is not provided – bring a shooting stick if you wish. Wheel chairs would be difficult.

Car parking will be allowed on the esplanade from 6.00pm, as long as you submit your car description (ie Ford Fiesta) and registration number with your application. Transport will be arranged into the castle. Applications should be made on the tear-off slip below stating which of the dates are suitable, enclosing a cheque for the cost of £18 per member.
